## CERTIFICATE PROGRAMME IN MODERN GREEK

### Modern Greek for Beginners (100 hours/Whole year)

**January 13—April 30, 2009: Tuesday/Thursday: 4:00 p.m.—6:00 p.m.**

**June 1—June 17, 2009: Monday through Friday: 9:30 a.m.—12:30 p.m.**

This 100-hour course aims to teach complete beginners the basics of Modern Greek in the four linguistic skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Vocabulary and grammar will be presented in a communicative way using social contexts to make the lessons interesting and lively. Students will learn to express themselves in a variety of situations, for example, making introductions, leave-taking, giving directions, buying things, and making telephone calls, to name the most important task-oriented assignments.

Classes will be held twice a week: **Tuesday and Thursday, 4:00 p.m.—6:00 p.m.**

Classes will start on **January, Tuesday, 13, 2009**, and will end on **Thursday, April 30, 2009**.

After a one-month break, classes will resume on **Monday, June 1**, and will end on **Wednesday, June 17, 2009**. Between June 1—17, 2009, classes will be held **Monday through Friday, 9:30 a.m.—12:30 p.m.**, ending on **Wednesday, June 17, 2009**.
